



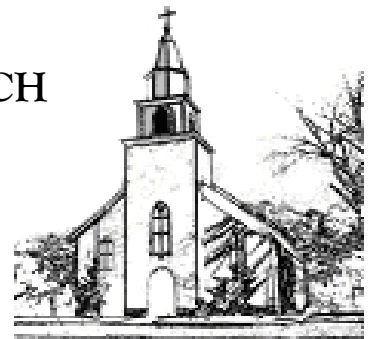

Rejoice, again I say, rejoice, Alleluia!

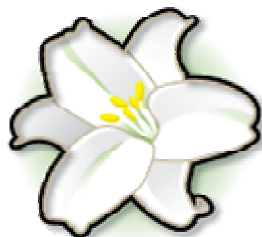
He sits at God's right hand till all His foes submit,
