



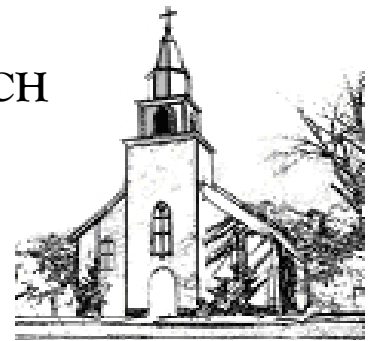

From the pastor's desk...

YOUR ATTENTION PLEASE....

Dear brothers and sisters,

I am writing this to thank you all for what you are doing for our parishes and school. With your support of time, talents and treasure, we are able to keep going. I am proud of you all for trying to live your faith in a deeper way. May the Lord bless you all.

I am also interested to bring to your attention about the Capital Campaign (building fund) we have started long ago. As of now, we owe the Diocese \$430,547.00, and we are paying \$4,500.00 per month towards this loan, of which \$2,600.00 is going to principal amount and \$1,900.00 to the interest. If we keep the same pace of payment, it will take us 12 years to pay off the loan.

As the world is experiencing the financial crunch and we too share the same, I know it is hard for all of us to keep the head above the water. The global recession has affected all of us and it reflected the capital Campaign in an adverse manner. We did not have enough money (\$ 4,500.00) to make the monthly payment. We had to take a couple of times money from the church general account to make the monthly payment. Now, we are hardly taking in enough to meet the payment. Therefore I personally appeal to each and every member of the parish (es) to extend your whole hearted support and cooperation in making the monthly payment.

Forgetting and forgiving is the hallmark of Christian life. If we really want to be true Christians, we should be prepared to leave behind the past with its imperfections and look forward with hope and optimism. We all have our own imperfections, either in a small way or big way, but our faith in the person of Jesus will make us bury them in His tomb and rise up with better hope. We have difference of opinion regarding the construction of the Parish Life Center and gym, but let us not forget that these facilities are at the disposal of each of us irrespective of our personal opinions and we use them to our convenience as to give expressions to our faith experience. As we share the good things around us, let us also be prepared to share the burden together and get out of this debt as early as possible.

Please support..... and cooperate..... in your own way!

So let us all as a Catholic community, think, reflect, pray, and to listen to the dictates of our Master, Jesus, and do what we can. In the gospel we read, how the Lord appreciated the little penny of the poor widow; so also whatever dime you put in will be appreciated by the Lord and His community here. Let us not forget the fact, "little drops makes an ocean."

CHILDREN'S LITURGY for 3 YRS THROUGH 1ST GRADE

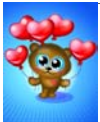
