From the pastor's desk...

SHOW YOUR GRATITUDE TO GOD

“Is there a reason for me to be thankful today?” If you are alive to read the question, then you have a reason for rejoicing! It may not always seem that way when troubles press in on you, but as long as you are alive, you have the opportunity to change your life and move forward.
